How You Can Help

The following is a list of ways that you can get involved. This list is not exhaustive, so if you have a special skill that you would like to share, please let us know.

Client Activities

Art

Assist instructor in classes, do prep work

BINGO

Assist participants as they play BINGO, assist with giving out prizes

Games

Spend time with participants as they do puzzles, play card games or dominoes

Music

Join participants during music, sing along

Manicures

Remove polish, file nails, apply lotion to hands, apply new polish (no nail clipping)

Gardening

Help with upkeep of special garden boxes (herbs, strawberries, etc.)

Special Group Leader

Lead participants in special group activity, such as devotion, current event discussion, poetry reading, or other area of interest

One-on-One

Spend focused time with a participant who needs extra attention

Office Assistance

Front Desk Reception

Answer phones, greet guests

Cleaning

Wipe tables, counters, and chairs, organize storage areas, pick up trash in front yard

Maintenance

Light maintenance, such as changing lightbulbs

For each event, volunteers needed prior to event, on event night, and post-event. Event night volunteers must be 18 or older.
